2017 Bond Overview

- ▶ \$172.5 Million Bond
- ▶ 10 Year Educational Facilities Master Plan:
 - ▶ Reduce Overcrowding
 - ▶ Increase Safety
 - ▶ Improve Educational Opportunities
- ▶ Facility Improvement for All 48 Schools
- ▶ 22 Major School Projects
- ▶ Mid-Way through Phase I
- ▶ Overall Investment of \$210 Million over 10 Years

- ▶ Timberline - Addition of Art & Science Wing
 - ▶ Currently moving into the new space
 - ▶ Ribbon Cutting scheduled for Aug 29th at 10 AM
- ▶ Dennis Technical Educational Center (DTEC) Expansion
 - ▶ Scheduled to be completed in mid August
 - ▶ Ribbon Cutting scheduled for Aug 28th at 10:30 AM
- ▶ Amity - New School
 - ▶ Scheduled to be complete by mid August
 - ▶ Demolition currently underway on the old building
 - ▶ Ribbon Cutting scheduled for Aug 30th at 10 AM
- ▶ Whittier
 - ▶ Scheduled to be completed mid December
- ▶ Boise High New Gym and Music Wing
 - ▶ Scheduled to be complete by Late February/Early March
